Class Descriptions

Art: Instructor is Anna Kennedy. Please note that classes have all new lessons! Classes offerings are as follows:

K-2nd Grade: **Young Rembrandts**; elementary drawing class; concepts include balancing composition, placement, perception, and attention to details. **(Cost: \$80)**

3 - 5th Grade **Hooked on Art**; Students will create stunning paintings, drawings and 3D art drawings using different kinds of media such as paint, pastels, and ink. **(Cost: \$53)**

6th and up **Adventures in Art**; Students will embark on artistic adventures into the world of ink, pastels, paints, and 3-dimensional art, and much more. **(Cost: \$53)**

Art History: Instructor is Tracey Joyner.

3 - 5th Grade Famous Artists and Their World -- Each week we will discuss the lives of one or two famous artists, their medium, style, and formative years. The students will be able to do exercises and projects which mimic the style of the artist, and learn the time and place influencing their work. Various media will be used, from fiction and non-fiction stories, videos or show presentations. History, culture and geography will play a large part in our class. Because this class is aimed at will emphasize the artists' contributions to art history and development rather than their personal, social or characteristics. Maximum 10 Children. **(Cost \$15)**

Theatre: Instructors are **Eric and Julie Fornelli**. Eric is a youth leader and worship leader at Three Rivers Church. He holds a BA in Biblical Studies at Trinity University in Deerfield. Julie hold a Masters degree in English and Communications and Culture, with a minor in music, also from Trinity. She is a certified teacher with over 4 years of middle school teaching experience who is currently raising her twins. Their class offerings are as follows:

K-2nd Grade Students will begin to understand and practice basic choral techniques, choreography, and public speaking. **(Cost: \$30)**

3 - 6th Grade Students will practice basic choral techniques, choreography, drama skills, and public speaking, re-enacting the birth story of Christ. Theatre classes will end with an evening where family and friends get to enjoy seeing the theatre skills learned by the students. 6th & Up ***Video Production Class:*** Students will practice basic concepts of film-making utilizing storyboards, camera techniques, and basic digital editing skills while incorporating story elements. Students will work in teams to create their own video. The videos will be shown at our family night in December **(Cost: \$65 -- includes materials)**

K - 2nd Grade Follow the Thayer Family through the wild west in the 1800's. Share the fun, adventure, and hard work of daily life. Make a mobile, pueblo house, fruit leather, a pioneer diary, toss & catch game, and lots more! **(Cost: \$25)**

Beatrix Potter Classics -- Instructor is Jessica Pierson

K - 2nd Grade Visit Peter Rabbit, Squirrel Nutkin, Mr. Jeremy Fisher, and many other friends in this fun class based on Beatrix Potter's little books. Each week we will read about a new friend and study the story. This is a cross-curriculum class that will include language arts, reading, science, art, & critical thinking concepts. For K-3rd grade, min. 5 max. 10. There are no minimum reading skills required as we will all work together to enjoy Mrs. Potter's works. **(Cost \$10)**

Proverbs and the Patriots Club -- Instructor is Penny Pfizenmaier.

3 - 5th Grade In this club the children are acquainted with American patriots who displayed God's wisdom and values as taught in the book of Proverbs. Each week we will address a single Christian Value, and show how that value is demonstrated through the life and sacrifice of an American people. **(Cost: \$10)**
